A STEP FORWARD INCLUSIVENESS AND ACCESSIBILITY



WHO IS THE SERVICE ADDRESSED TO DESCRIPTION AND CHARACTERISTICS

The short-term car rental service for people with disabilities provides specially adapted vehicles to enable those with a special driving licence to drive. These vehicles are equipped with systems that provide a comfortable and safe driving experience for customers with disabilities.



WHO IS THE SERVICE ADDRESSED TO

Persons with disabilities, specifically: paraplegia, paralysis of the lower limbs, or absence of a lower or upper limb, who hold a special driving licence.



ADAPTED VEHICLES

The fleet includes automatic FIAT 500X and automatic OPEL CORSA vehicles.

Customer service is available from Monday to Saturday.




ACCESSIBLE HOLIDAYS INFORMATION IS A PRIORITY

SRC AND ANGLAT: A SYNERGY FOR INCLUSIVITY

SRC is a partner of **ANGLAT**, a national association for social promotion that has been operating since 1980, including internationally, to represent and protect the rights of people with disabilities and their families, primarily in the areas of mobility, driving, transport and accessibility. It is active in Italy with **160,000 holders of special licences for driving adapted vehicles**.

The cars of the **Next to this Ability** service will also be rentable by foreigners who will thus have the opportunity to explore our treasures cultural and landscape in full independence; we are belived that we will contribute to shaping an image of Italy as a destination inclusive and welcoming tourism.

Next to This Ability is not just a service: it is a shared vision that takes shape thanks to meaningful collaborations and encounters with organisations that believe in the same values of inclusion, accessibility and community. Our partnerships are not mere showcases, but spaces for dialogue and co-design, where values, ideas and people come together to build mobility that breaks down barriers and creates new opportunities for participation.

The project was born with a clear goal: to make mobility a universal right by breaking down the barriers that too often limit people with disabilities.

A commitment that is not confined to words, but translates into concrete actions, collaborations and participation in events of national and international importance.

The launch of Next to This Ability also received special recognition from institutions: Minister for Disabilities **Alessandra Locatelli** sent us a message of support, emphasising the importance of initiatives such as ours in ensuring equal opportunities for mobility and social inclusion. This encouragement confirms that our commitment is not only corporate, but part of a shared journey with institutions and the entire community.



In September 2024, we took an important step by joining the network of AISM – Italian Multiple Sclerosis Association, becoming Mobility Partner of the project 'La vita indipendente non va in vacanza' (www.lavitandipendentenonvainvacanza.it).

An initiative sponsored by **ENIT**-the Italian National Tourism Agency – and supported by various regional administrations – **Piedmont**, **Lazio**, **Emilia Romagna** and **Sicily** – which promotes independence, accessibility and the right to travel for all people.

Also in our capacity as Mobility Partner, we contributed to Palermo for All, a memorandum of understanding that brings together **AISM**, **Bil Benefit** and the **Municipality of Palermo**, with the aim of transforming the city into an increasingly welcoming, inclusive and accessible place. This challenge focuses on the concept of "independent living" and the need to transform it from an aspiration into an inalienable right.

Next to This Ability's commitment has also been recognised on an international level. In October 2024, we were present at the **G7 Inclusion and Disability Summit** in Assisi as AISM Rental Partner, providing adapted vehicles for the event's official shuttle service. This participation allowed us to share our testimony and experience in a space for dialogue between institutions, associations and businesses, confirming that inclusion is a global value and a shared responsibility.

In addition to this journey, we participated in the **ICCAR Bootcamp** on inclusion, promoted by **UNESCO** and dedicated to inclusive cities: an opportunity to meet young people from all over the world, where we presented Next to This Ability as a model of good practice that can be replicated internationally.

These partnerships and experiences demonstrate how Next to This Ability is more than just a service: **it is a bridge between people, values and events**, capable of creating communities and transforming mobility into an opportunity for social, cultural and economic growth.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION ELECRONIC HAND THROTTLE

ELECTRONIC HAND THROTTLE FOR DISABLED DRIVING

community code 25.04

Disabled car rental driving systems include the ring accelerator placed above the steering wheel is suitable for people with limited lower limb function, paraplegia. Acceleration is achieved simply by applying light pressure anywhere on the rim. Allows smooth driving in complete freedom by allowing both hands to remain on the steering wheel. Reliable, maneuverable and super lightweight, it integrates seamlessly with the steering wheel.

The disabled driving device is available in a **Quick Release** removable rim version.





TECHNICAL INFORMATION MANUAL SERVICE BRAKE

MANUAL SERVICE BRAKE FOR DISABLED DRIVING

community code 20.06

The brake lever is a disabled car rental driving device suitable for use by drivers with lower limb disabilities.

The device is designed to allow the brake pedal to be operated using only the upper limbs. With an innovative shape, it does not obstruct the driver's range of motion. The lever is designed and manufactured with an optimal ratio of force to resistance, thus ensuring greater and more effective braking with minimal effort.





TECHNICAL INFORMATION PUSH-BUTTON PANEL

INFRARED CONTROL UNIT FOR DISABLED DRIVING

community code 35.03/35.04

The device applied to the steering wheel allows, by means of a push-button panel, very rapid operation of light controls, turn signals, windshield wipers, horn, etc...

In addition, to facilitate night vision, illumination of symbols is provided by means of a button. The device is equipped with a knob for turning the steering wheel and can be applied to either the left or right side. The remote control can be taken out through a button in the middle of the knob, and the rechargeable lithium battery provides a long battery life.





TECHNICAL INFORMATION LEFT ACCELERATOR PEDAL

LEFT ACCELERATOR PEDAL FOR DISABLED DRIVING

community code 25.07/25.08

This adaptation allows the driver to be able to accelerate with the left leg. For safety purposes, as required by current regulations, the device is completed with a removable bulkhead useful for covering the original accelerator pedal.

The system is designed so that the use of the accelerator on the right can be restored in seconds and with great ease.
